



# Verified Weight Declaration (VGM)

## What mandatory information is required before a container can be processed for receipt and loading?

- 1 Verified Gross Mass of the container
- 2 The method used to obtain the VGM; and
- 3 The name and contact details of the shipper or person authorised by the shipper to make the declaration.

Please refer to the new SOLAS-VGM regulations or ask Magellan Logistics for information on the weight declaration compliance and the two methods that are allowed to be used to ascertain the verified gross mass(VGM). SOLAS (VGM) compliance is effective from 1 July 2016
